

## INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS an AGREEMENT ON ASEAN PREFERENTIAL
TRADING ARRANGEMENTS was signed in Manila on February 24,
1977 by the Foreign Ministers of the Republic of Indonesia, Malaysia,
the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, and the
Kingdom of Thailand;

AND WHEREAS article 17 paragraph 1 of the Agreement requires that it be subject to ratification;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Thailand, having considered the Agreement, hereby ratifies the same.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.

DONE at Bangkok this 26th day of July in the year two thousand five hundred and twenty of the Buddhist Era (corresponding to the year 1977 of the Christian Era).
