Your Excellency,


I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of Your Excellency's letter dated June 28, 1984 informing me that the Government of Japan is now ready to make a contribution of one million US dollars (US\$1,000,000) to ASEAN in the fiscal year 1984, in pursuance of the proposals for the establishment of a scholarship for ASEAN Youth announced by the late Prime Minister Masayosi Ohira in Manila in May 1979, the discussions of the ASEAN - JAPAN Officials Meeting held in Tokyo on 26-27 September 1979, and with reference to the letter of His Excellency Tengku Ahmad Rithaudeen, the then Chairman of the ASEAN Standing Committee, to the then Foreign Minister Saburo Okita, dated December 20, 1979.

On behalf of the Governments of ASEAN, I am pleased to affirm the understanding that the contribution shall be made available only for financing the Japan Scholarship for ASEAN Youth to be implemented in accordance with the guidelines for the Japan Scholarship for ASEAN Youth drawn up at the aforementioned Officials Meeting.

I now have the honour to request the Government of Japan, through Your Excellency's Embassy, to disburse the sum of one million US dollars (US\$1,000,000) corresponding to the above-mentioned contribution.

YOUR EXCELLENCY,

I HAVE THE HONOUR TO INFORM YOUR EXCELLENCY THAT PURSUANT TO THE PROPOSAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN YOUTH BY THE LATE PRIME MINISTER MASAYOSHI OHIRA IN MANILA IN MAY 1979, AND TO THE DISCUSSIONS OF THE ASEAN - JAPAN OFFICIALS MEETING HELD IN TOKYO ON 26 - 27 SEPTEMBER 1979, AND WITH REFERENCE TO THE LETTER OF HIS EXCELLENCY TENGKU AHMAD RITHAUDDEEN, THE THEN CHAIRMAN OF THE ASEAN STANDING COMMITTEE, TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE THEN FOREIGN MINISTER SABURO OKITA, DATED DECEMBER 20, 1979, THE GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN IS NOW READY TO MAKE A CONTRIBUTION OF ONE MILLION U.S. DOLLARS (US \$1,000,000) TO ASEAN IN THE FISCAL YEAR 1985 ON THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THE CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE ONLY FOR FINANCING THE JAPAN SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN YOUTH TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES FOR THE JAPAN SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN YOUTH DRAWN UP AT THE AFOREMENTIONED OFFICIALS MEETING.

I SINCERELY HOPE THAT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED UNDERSTANDING IS AGREEABLE TO YOUR EXCELLENCY AND AN EARLY REPLY, INDICATING ALSO THE BANK ACCOUNT TO WHICH THE CONTRIBUTION SHOULD BE DEPOSITED, WOULD BE HIGHLY APPRECIATED.

ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ASEAN, I AM PLEASED TO AFFIRM THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THE CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE MADE ^AAVAILABLE ONLY FOR FINANCING THE JAPAN SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN YOUTH TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES FOR THE JAPAN SCHOLARSHIP FOR ASEAN YOUTH DRAWN UP AT THE AFOREMENTIONED OFFICIALS MEETING.

I NOW HAVE THE HONOUR TO REQUEST THE GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN, THROUGH YOUR EXCELLENCY'S EMBASSY, TO DISBURSE THE SUM OF ONE MILLION US DOLLARS (US \$1,000,000) CORRESPONDING TO THE ABOVE-MENTIONED CONTRIBUTION.
