



THE GOVERNMENT OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

**INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING
THE ASEAN PROMOTION CENTRE ON TRADE, INVESTMENT AND
TOURISM**

WHEREAS the Agreement Establishing the ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement) was signed by Japan and the member countries of the Association of South East Asian Nations on the 22nd December, 1980 and extended on 23rd April, 1987 for another period of five years beginning 25th May 1987.

AND WHEREAS Article 22 provides that the said Agreement shall be subject to ratification or Acceptance by the signatories;

AND WHEREAS, Brunei Darussalam being a member country of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations has decided to become a party to the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH, the amendment to the first paragraph of the Preamble of the Agreement, the Government of Brunei Darussalam, having considered the Agreement, hereby **CONFIRMS** and **ACCEPTS** the same and undertakes to perform and carry out faithfully the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, PRINCE MOHAMED BOLKIAH, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Brunei Darussalam have signed this Instrument of Acceptance and affixed my official seal;
