

## **INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL**

WHEREAS, the Agreement between the Governments of the Member Countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and the Government of the Russian Federation on Economic and Development Cooperation was done at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 10 December 2005;
