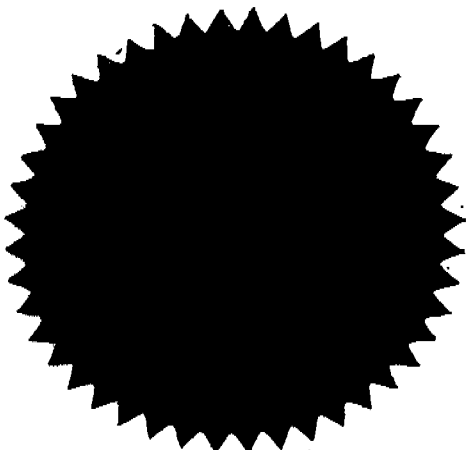
AND WHEREAS the Agreement was signed on behalf of the Government of Malaysia on the same date;
