

## Instrument of Ratification

**WHEREAS** the Protocol 5 on the ASEAN Scheme of Compulsory Motor Vehicle Insurance was done at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, on 8 April 2001, by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand, and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam; and

**WHEREAS** Article 15 paragraph 3 of the aforesaid Protocol provides that this Protocol is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties, and that the Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN who shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit.

**THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND**, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

**DONE** at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of January in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Forty-six of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Three of the Christian Era.
