INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

KNOW YE, that whereas, *Protocol 8, Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures to Implement the ASEAN Framework Agreement on the Facilitation of Goods in Transit* was signed on 27 October 2000 in Phnom Penh;

WHEREAS, Articles 19, 22 and 25 of the *ASEAN Framework Agreement on the Facilitation of Goods in Transit (Agreement)*, which was signed on 16 December 1998, provide for the conclusion of implementing Protocols which shall form integral parts thereof;

WHEREAS, under Article 2 thereof, the provisions of *Protocol 8* shall apply to the transit of goods in the territories of the Contracting Parties, particularly where transit among ASEAN Member States which are parties to this Protocol is involved;

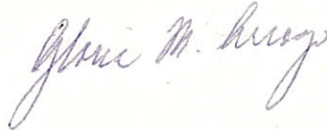
WHEREAS, Article 6 (4) of *Protocol 8* provides that *it shall enter into force upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance by all Contracting Parties with the Secretary-General of ASEAN*;

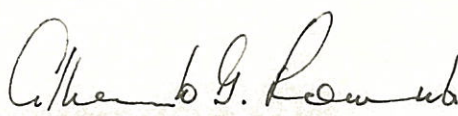
