

WHEREAS the Protocol **No.** 9 on Dangerous Goods to Implement the **ASEAN** Framework Agreement on the **Facilitation** of Goods in Transit was signed at Jakarta, Indonesia **on** 20 **September** 2002,

AND WHEREAS the said Protocol was **signed** on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore **on** that date,



AND WHEREAS Paragraph 4 of Article 7 of the Protocol No. 9 provides that it shall enter into force upon **the** deposit of instruments of ratification or acceptance by att Contracting Parties with the Secretary-General of ASEAN,

NOW THEREFORE I, George **Yong-Boon** Yeo, Minister for Foreign declaring the Government of the Republic of Singapore, having considered the above mentioned **Protocol**, ratifies the same **and** undertakes **faithfully** to perform and carry **out** the stipulations therein contained.
