KNOW YE, that whereas, the ASEAN Convention on Counter Terrorism was signed on 13 January 2007 in Cebu;

WHEREAS, the Convention aims to provide the framework for regional cooperation to counter, prevent and suppress terrorism in all its forms and manifestations, and deepen cooperation among law enforcement agencies and relevant authorities of the Parties in countering terrorism;

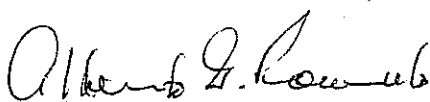
