**AND WHEREAS**, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed by Minister for Ministry of Foreign Affairs on behalf of the Union of Myanmar;

**AND WHEREAS**, paragraph 2 and 3 of Article 7 of the aforesaid Memorandum of Understanding provide that the MOU is subject to ratification or acceptance by all the member countries and that the MOU shall enter into force upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance by all member countries with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

**NOW THEREFORE**, The Government of the Union of Myanmar, having considered the aforesaid MOU, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained;

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister for Ministry of Energy of the Union of Myanmar.

**DONE**, at the Ministry of Energy, Nay Pyi Taw, the Union of Myanmar on this 3<sup>rd</sup> Waning of the Month of First Waso in the Year One Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy Two of the Myanmar Era corresponding to the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June in the Year Two Thousand and Ten of Christian Era.
