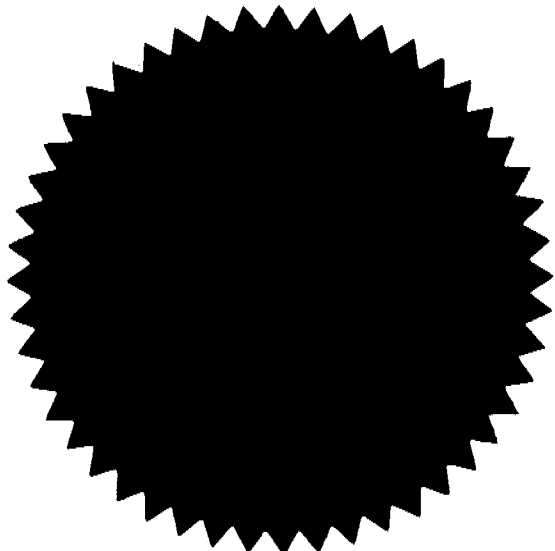
ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEAST ASIAN NATIONS (ASEAN)

**W**HEREAS the Government of the Republic of Singapore has set up at the seat of ASEAN in Jakarta, Republic of Indonesia, a Permanent Mission to maintain necessary contact with ASEAN.

Now therefore, I, SELLAPAN RAMANATHAN, President of the Republic of Singapore, have appointed and by these presents do confirm as Permanent Representative to ASEAN in Jakarta, Republic of Indonesia, Mr LIM THUAN KUAN, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Singapore.

Mr LIM THUAN KUAN is instructed to represent the Government of the Republic of Singapore in all organs of ASEAN. He is also authorised to designate a substitute to act temporarily on his behalf after due notice to the Secretary-General.
